#### Fees Detail:

### FOR SCHOOLS IN INDIA

A participation fee of  $\Box$ 125 (including GST) per student per Olympiad must be collected by the school from students on behalf of the Lions Olympiad Foundation and sent to the Foundation. Additionally, the school may collect an extra  $\Box$ 25 per student per Olympiad for the honorarium of the incharge, teacher remuneration and miscellaneous expenses.

#### FOR SCHOOLS OUTSIDE INDIA

A participation fees of USD 6 (including GST) per student per Olympiad must be collected by the school from students on behalf of the Lions Olympiad Foundation and sent to the Foundation. Additionally, the school may collect an extra USD 2 per student per Olympiad for teacher remuneration and miscellaneous expenses.

#### **INSTRUCTIONS**

Instructions for Medal Distribution Criteria for School:

7 to 10 participants in a subject and class – Only the top rank holder receives the Gold Medal.

Upto 25 participants in a subject and class – Top 3 rank holders receive Gold, Silver, and Bronze Medals.

More than 25 participants in a subject and class - Top 10% rank holders receive medals, leading to an increase in the total number of medals awarded.

## **EXAMPLE:**

For top 4 out of 35 participants, will get 2 Gold + 1 Silver + 1 Bronze	For top 5 out of 45 participants, will get 2 Gold + 2 Silver + 1 Bronze
For top 6 out of 55 participants, will get 2 Gold + 2 Silver + 2 Bronze	For top 7 out of 65 participants, will get 3 Gold + 2 Silver + 2 Bronze.
For top 8 out of 75 participants, will get 3 Gold + 3 Silver + 2 Bronze.	For top 9 out of <mark>85 participants,</mark> will get 3 Gold + 3 Silver + 3 Bronze.
For top 10 out of 95 participants, will get 4 Gold + 3 Silver + 3 Bronze.	This distribution scales accordingly with participant count.

Note: Medals awarded at any level in the Olympiad will be symbolic Gold, Silver and Bronze Medals, respectively.
